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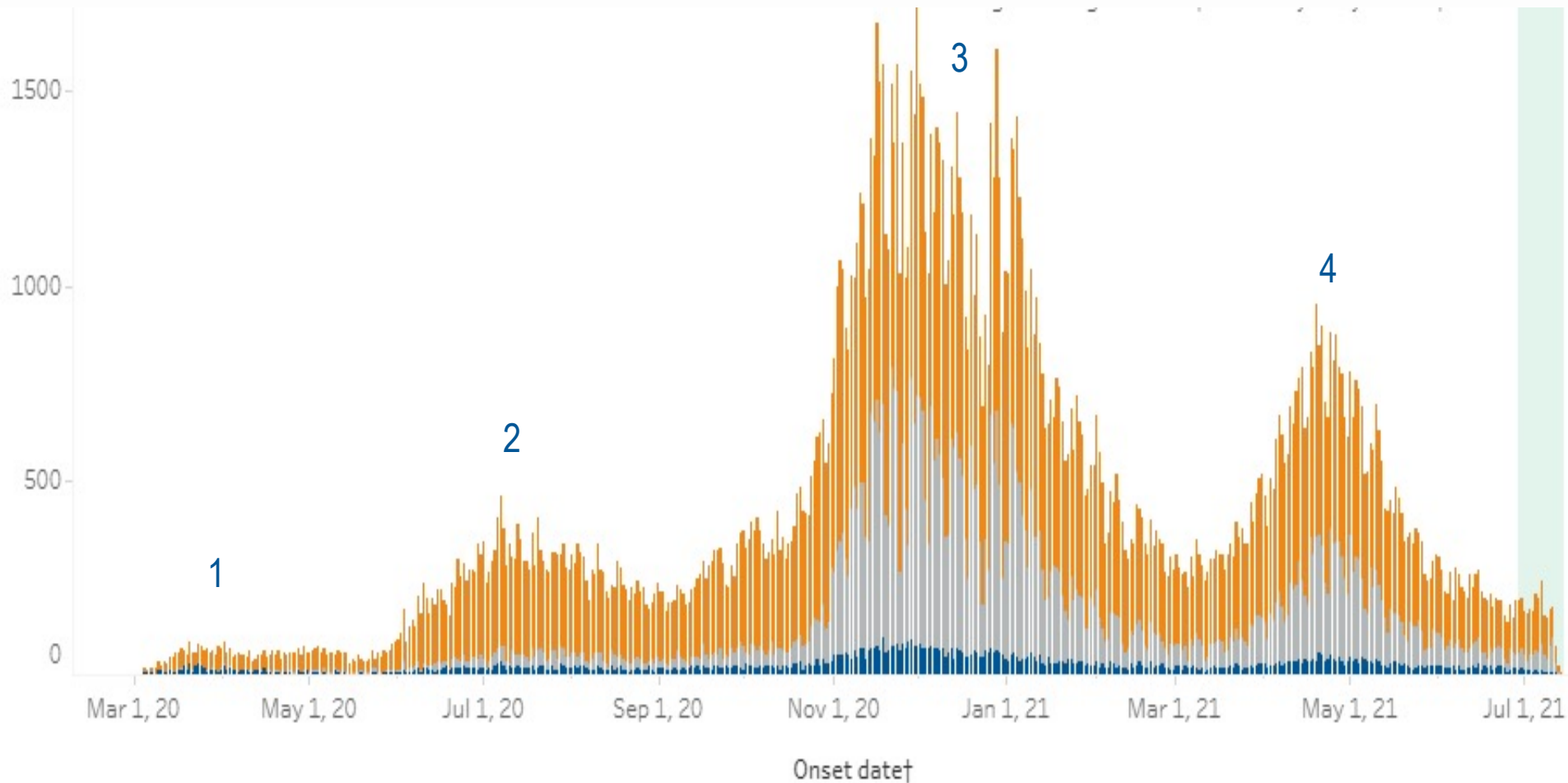

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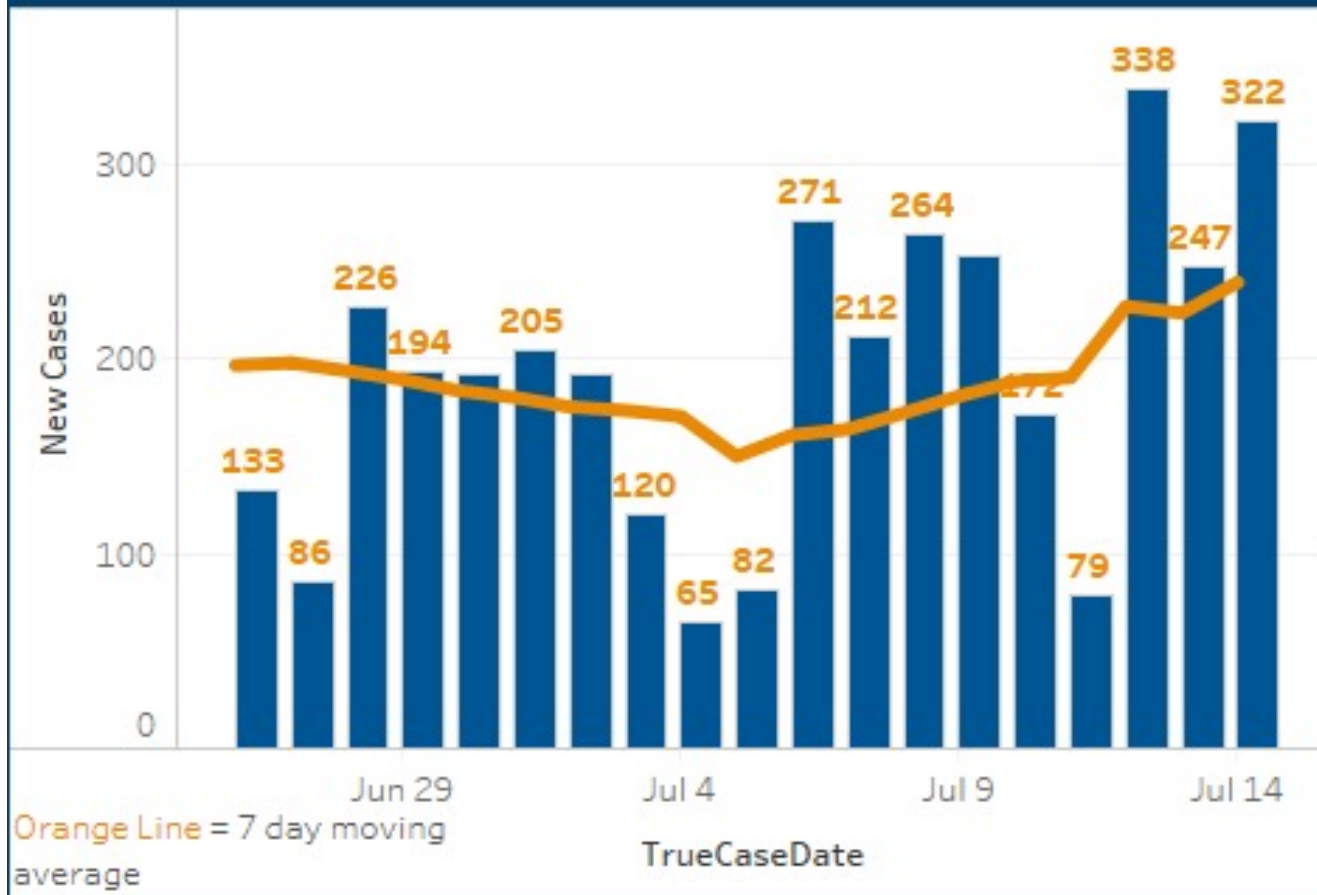


# Oregon's epidemiologic curve

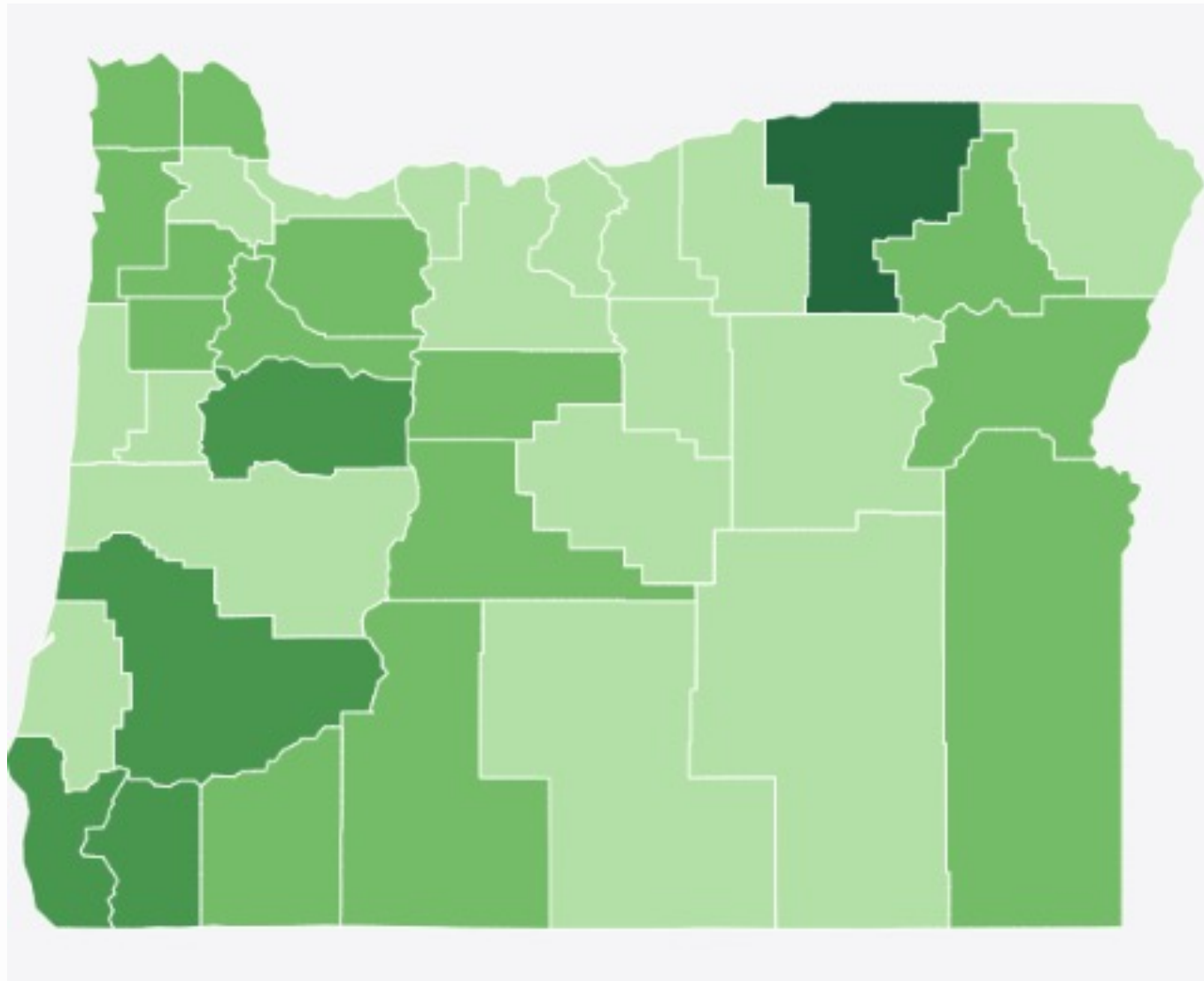


# Oregon's epidemiologic curve

Daily Cases and 7 Day Average in the Current and Previous 2 MMWR Weeks - All



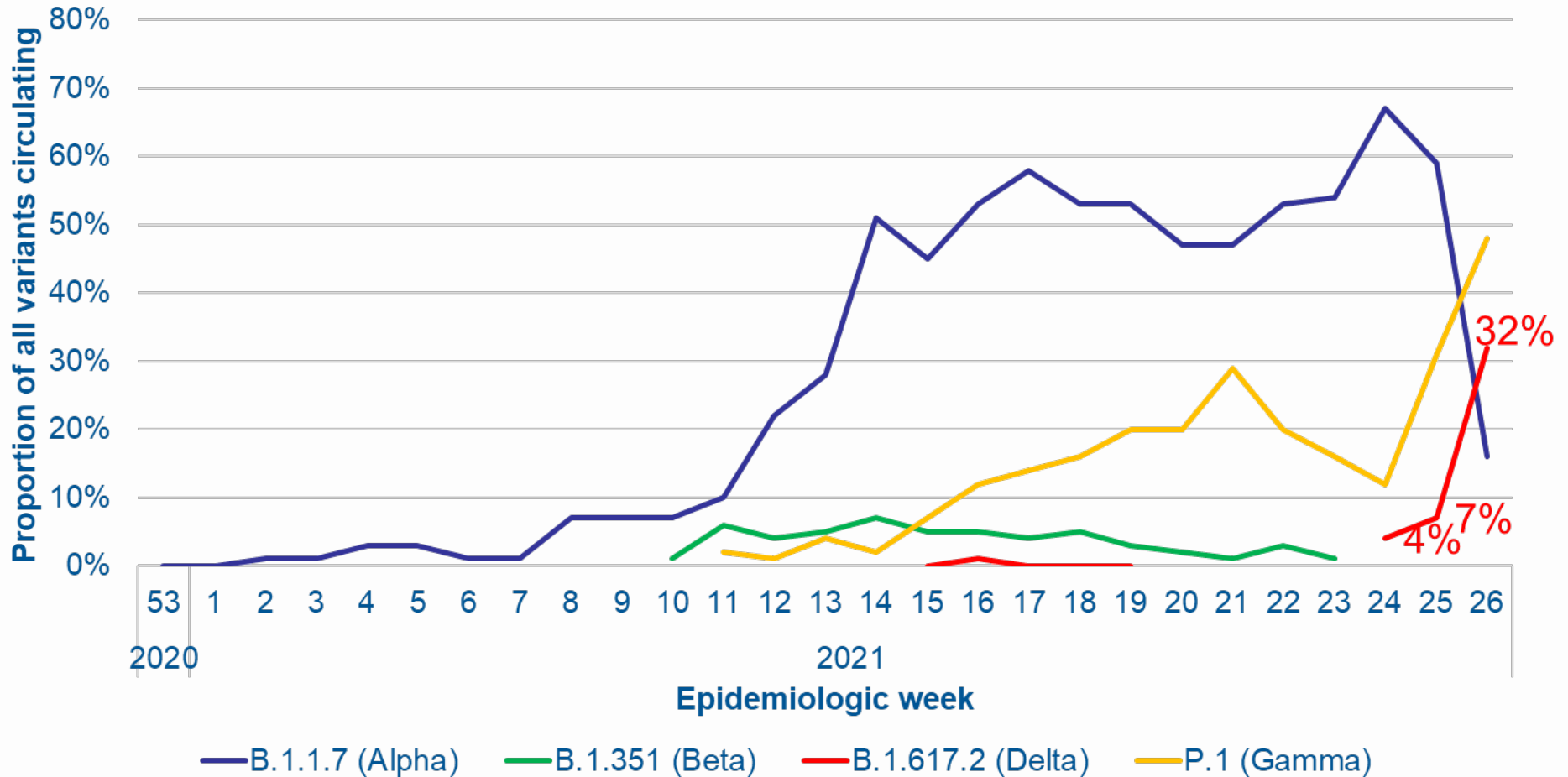
# Oregon transmission levels by county

# COVID-19 variant of concern circulation in Oregon

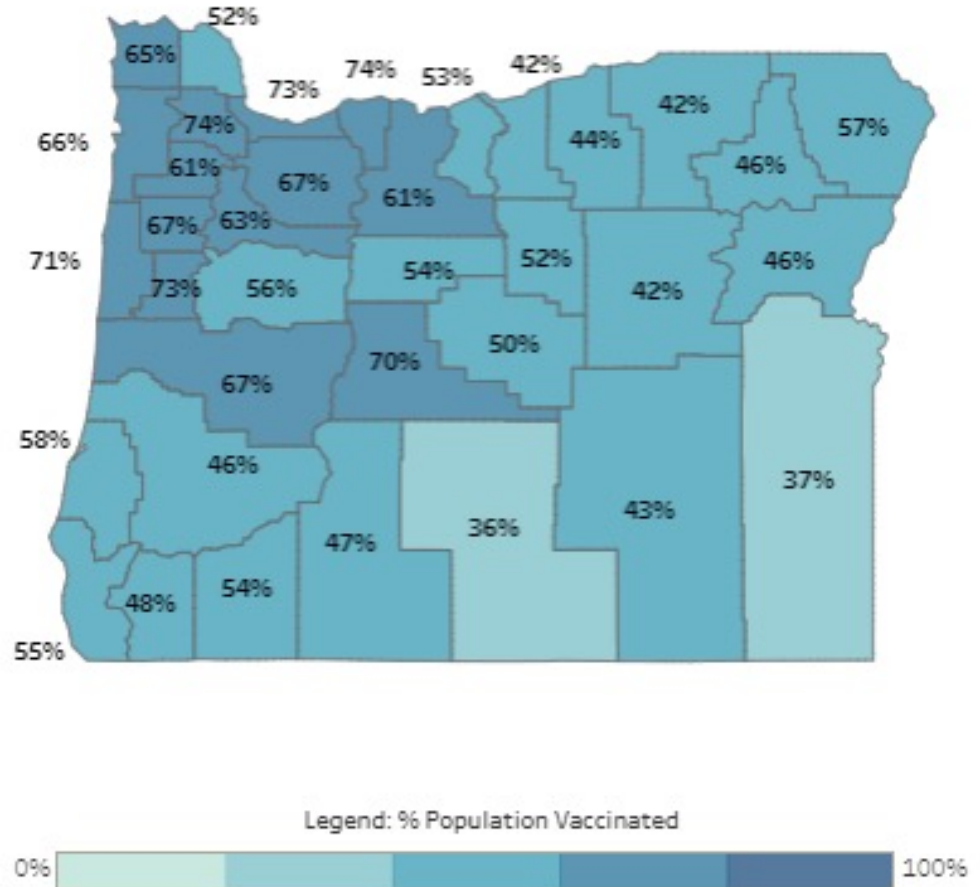


## B.1.617.2 (Delta) variant

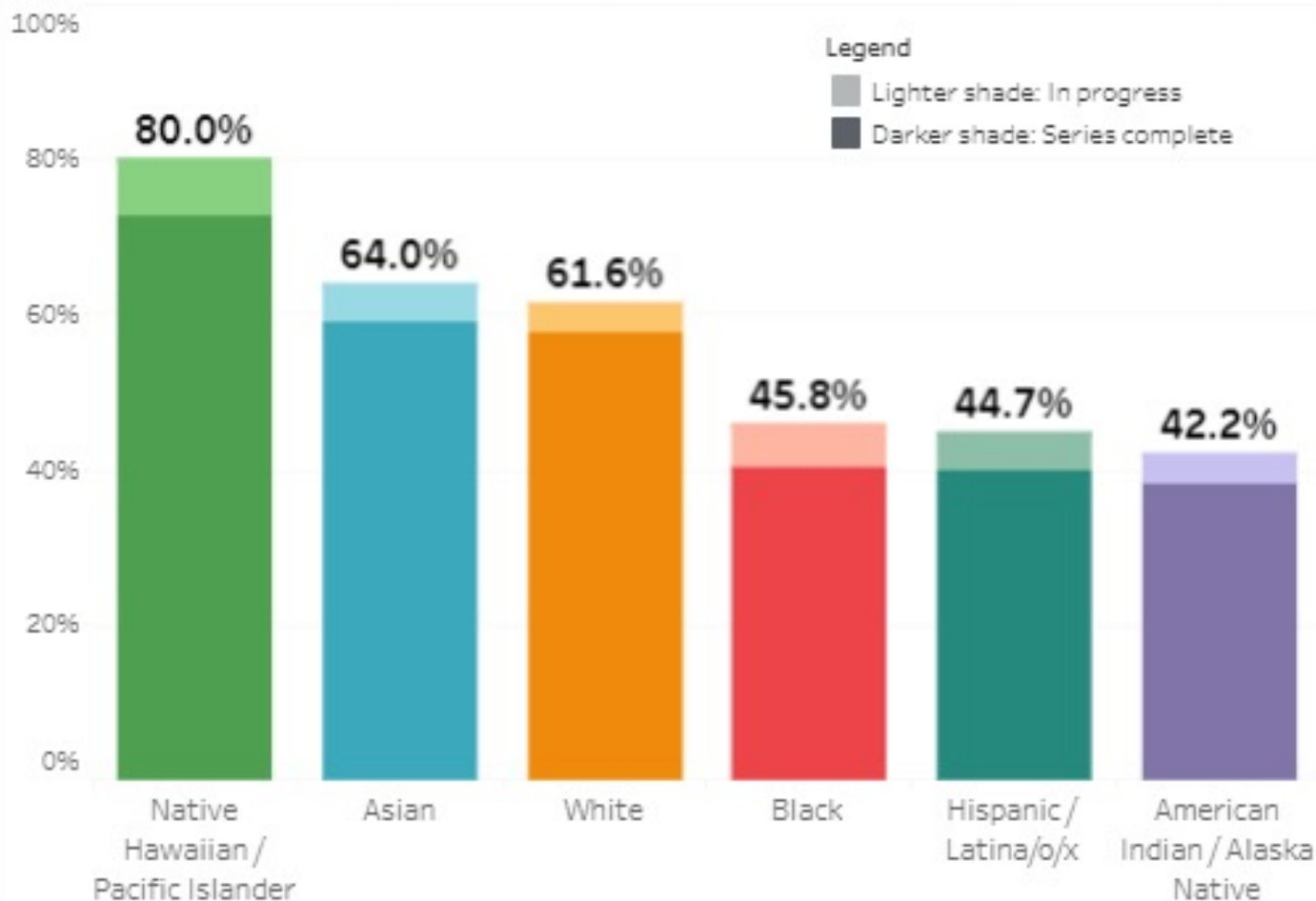
- Approximately 2-3-fold more transmissible than early COVID-19 variants
- Projected to become the dominant variant nationwide
- Reduced vaccine effectiveness against **symptomatic infection**
  - Israeli Ministry of Health: **64% effective**
- Maintained vaccine effectiveness against **severe infection**
  - Israeli Ministry of Health: **93% effective**

# COVID-19 vaccination rates

- Overall, **67.6%** of adults are vaccinated
- Vaccination rates vary from 36-74% by county



# COVID-19 vaccination rates by race/ethnicity

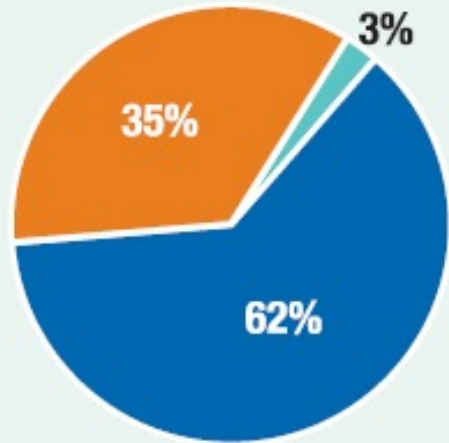




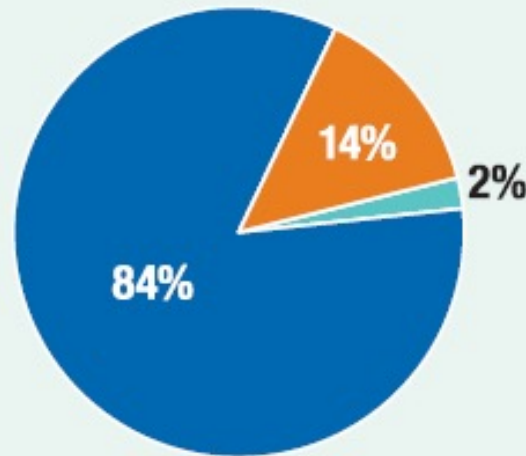
# COVID-19 vaccination rates by health care worker type

- Health care workers have an overall slightly higher rate of vaccination than the general population
- Tremendous variation by license
  - Dentists: **94%**
  - Physicians (MD): **87%**
  - Pharmacists: **78%**
  - Registered nurses: **74%**
  - Acupuncturist: **65%**
  - Paramedic: **64%**
  - Naturopath: **57%**
  - Chiropractors: **50%**

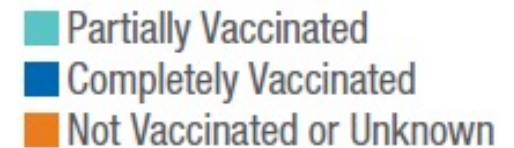
# COVID-19 vaccination rates within long-term care facilities



Staff (N=22,845)

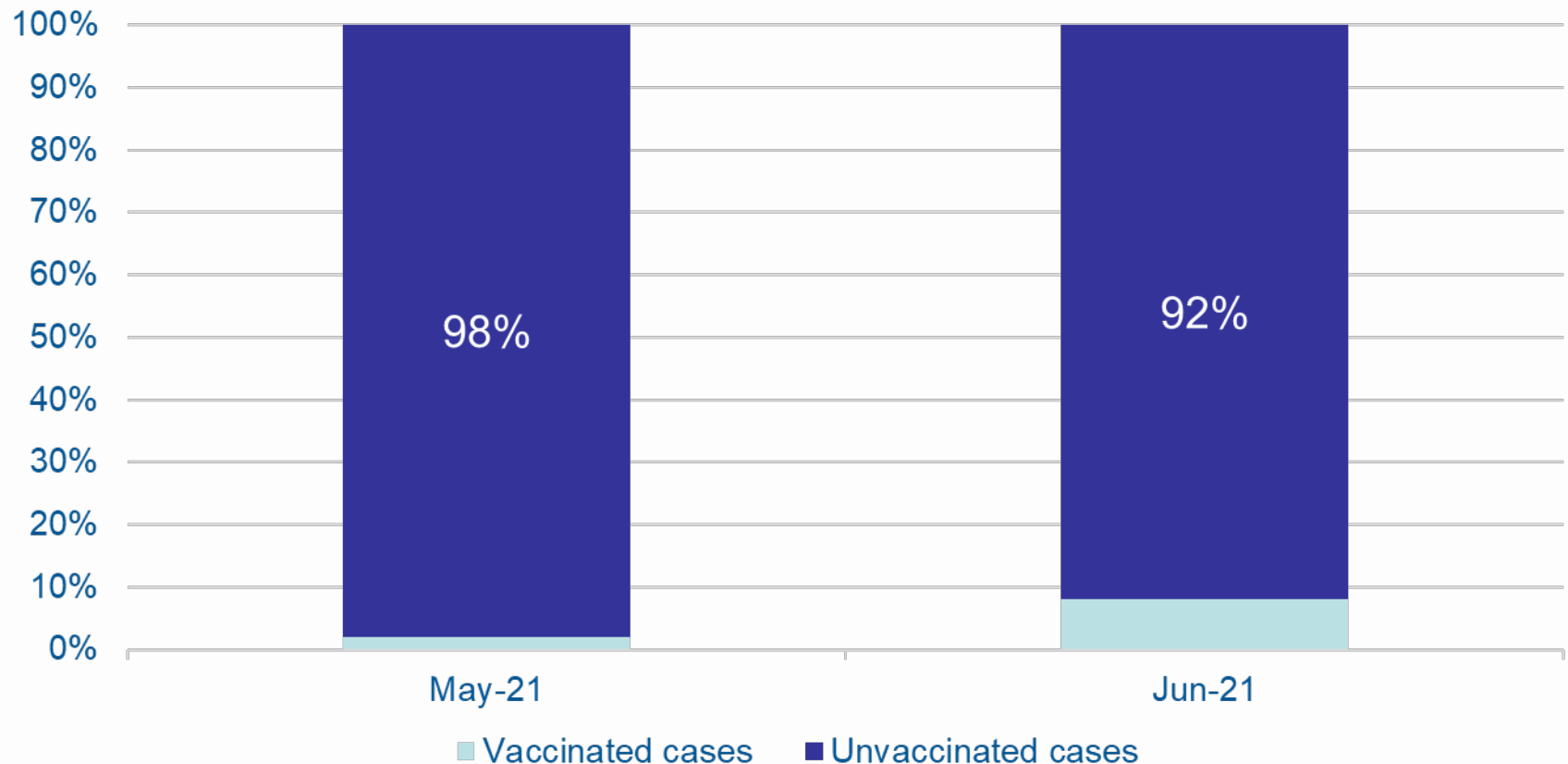


Residents (N=17,119)
