SERVICE ANIMAL POLICY

Service animals are allowed to accompany people with disabilities in the lobby, in sleeping rooms and any areas open to the general public.

Upon entering our business, you may be asked:

- Is the animal required because of a disability; and/or
- What work or task has the animal been trained to perform

All animals must be under control and housebroken. Dogs or therapy animals whose function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals according to the ADA.



PERSONAL PET POLICY

Pets, including emotional support animals, are only allowed in the lobby and outdoor areas and are not allowed in sleeping rooms.

The only animals allowed to stay in-room are service animals accompanying persons with disabilities.

Animals whose function is to provide emotional support, comfort, or companionship do not qualify as service animals according to the ADA.
